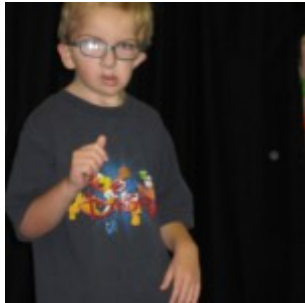


Week of Sept 28- Oct 2
